



Contract and Liability Statement 2024

Payment

Payment is due at least 24 before services are rendered and is accepted via Cash, Venmo, PayPal, Cash App. Corporate or government clients may pay via check. Please make checks payable to Liyan McNeltier. Invoices are emailed upon request. The client agrees to pay the full amount due under this contract, even if artist is used for less time than contracted.

Time Management

Face painter(s) CANNOT be responsible for ensuring all participants are painted before the event end time. Please note that depending on the length of the face painting line, the line may close 30-45 minutes before the end time of the event in order for face painter to avoid working past agreed-upon timeframe. If additional time is requested by the client (and the face painter is available), any time beyond the time booked will cost \$50.00 per half hour with a full half hour being charged for each 1-30 minutes of overtime for large group or public events or \$10.00 per additional child at private parties.

Parking

Face painter(s) will be provided with easily accessible parking on the property where services will be provided. If the event is at a commercial facility the artists will be provided a parking spot near the commercial facility entrance door for equipment unloading. If an accessible parking option is not available the face painter(s) has a right to deny or halt services. The client will reimburse the artist for any parking fees incurred while the artist is providing its services to the client.

Adverse Working Conditions

Face painter(s) has the right to cease painting and leave without refunding monies if there are adverse working conditions and the client fails to remedy the situation after it has been brought to their attention. Adverse conditions include (but are not limited to) rude, destructive, violent, or extreme behavior of a child or an adult; illegal activities; dangerous weather or work environment conditions (including wind or rain that may damage painting supplies); dangerous conditions in general; and harassment of the face painter(s) by either adult or child. In the event of a weather cancellation, the face painter may agree to a rescheduled date if discussed 48 hours before the event day and if availability permits.

Face Painter(s) Will Not Supervise Children

The behavior and safety of all children and adults is the responsibility of the client and none of the face painter(s). Any damage to the face painting equipment due to the negligence of others is the financial responsibility of the client. Please ensure that guests are not running or playing dangerously close to where the face painter(s) is painting.

Limits and Liability: Allergic Reactions, Health and Safety

The face painter is insured through Beauty & Body Work. Proof of insurance is available upon request. Supplies used are non-toxic, high-quality theatrical and cosmetic grade paints, makeup, and glitters.

Face painter(s) ARE NOT liable for allergic reactions to paints. People with skin allergies or sensitive skin should NOT participate. Although the artist strives to use only the safest materials, no product can guarantee it will not cause a reaction. It is the client's and/or parent's responsibility to be aware of sensitivities in regard to being face painted. If an allergic reaction does occur, paint should be removed immediately. Water and a soft cloth are typically all that is needed. The client understands that darker face paints may linger and must be removed with mild soap, water, and a washcloth. Some colors may temporarily stain the skin.

Face painter(s) IS NOT responsible for any adverse effects that other entertainment might have on the face painting, such as sweat (bounce houses), water (swimming pools), etc.

Face painter(s) WILL NOT paint anyone who is or appears to be sick or suffering from cold sores, conjunctivitis (pink eye), ringworm, sunburn, eczema, any infectious skin conditions, or open wounds. These determinations are at the discretion of the face painter(s).

For safety reasons, the artist will typically not paint children under the age of 3 or anyone who is unwilling, resistant, crying, or scared.

Face Painting Content Limitations: Face painter(s) retain the right to refuse to paint any part of the body that is not legal to expose in public, or any place face painter(s) does not feel comfortable painting. Face painter(s) retain the right to refuse to paint any design or wording that is obscene, offensive, or the painter deems to defy good taste. Face painter(s) retain the right to refuse to paint any symbols or other illustrations that are commonly associated with "gang" or other illegal group affiliations. Face painter(s) deem the right to refuse to paint copyrighted characters or any designs they are not comfortable painting. Face painter(s) retain the right to refuse to paint on any individual that is unwilling to be painted.

Acceptance of Contract

By booking, the client affirms that they have read, understand, and accept the terms of this contract and liability statement.
